Description:

Located on the west side of West Side Avenue is this one story, three bay log house which has been modified several times. It is covered with German siding. A shed roofed dormer extends from the front slope of the roof. Windows have two over two pane sash within molded flat topped architraves. A semi-hexagonal projecting bay has been added to the south side of the front elevation. The main entrance is located in the north end bay of the front elevation. A porch supported by round columns extends across the front. Alterations to the building make an estimate of its age difficult.

A building does appear on this site in the 1877 Atlas map of Funkstown, owned by P. Stouffer. It may have housed workers for the nearby Funkstown Manufacturing Company.


