Description:

Located on the west side of South Antietam Street is this two story, three bay frame house. Covered with German siding, it has a central entrance and windows with single pane sashes, which are probably replacements. An early 20th century porch with a brick base and wall extends across the front. A two story frame wing extends to the rear.

This house reflects the later development that occurred off Funkstown's main street. A house is shown on this site on the 1877 Atlas map for Funkstown, owned by J. Gower.
