Description:

This is a two story, three bay frame L-shaped house covered with asbestos shingle siding. Windows have single pane sash within architraves with molded flat tops. The main entrance is in the central bay of the front elevation and includes a transom. An early 20th century porch supported by round columns on square bases extends across the front. The exterior elements of this house suggest a construction date of ca. 1900.

There was, however, a building on this site according to the 1877 Atlas map for Funkstown. The building was owned by C. Stucks.
