Description:

Located on the north side of Cemetery Street is this two story, three bay frame L-shaped house. It is covered with vinyl siding. Windows have two over two pane sash within flat topped architraves. The main entrance is located in the central front bay. It is sheltered by a one bay entrance porch supported by round columns.

This house is typical of the later construction which occurred on Funkstown's side streets which occurred in the late 19th and 20th centuries.


