Description:

Located on the southwest corner of Green and High Streets is this two story, three bay log structure, covered with vinyl siding. It has six over six pane sash which are replacements. The front entrance is in the central bay of the east elevation. There is an across-the-front porch supported by turned posts with brackets. The south bay of the porch has been enclosed. There is also a shed extension to the south.

A house appears in this location in the 1877 Atlas map of Funkstown with the owner, D. Valentine.

High Street in this block ends at the Antietam Creek. This was one of the historic mill sites of Funkstown, just to the southeast of this house.
