Description:

This two story, three bay log house is covered with bevel-topped wooden siding. Windows have six over six pane sash. The two eastern openings in the front elevation are offset to the east. The front entrance is in the central bay and includes a transom. Character-defining features include an added cross gable with a double window from the 1890s or early 1900s and an early 20th century porch. The house is much older and of log construction. The siding is bevel-topped weatherboarding, a forerunner of German siding.

According to the 1877 Atlas, this was the property of Mrs. Hughes.
