Description:

This is a two story, three bay log house with a two story, two bay shed extension. It is covered with asbestos shingle siding. Windows have two over two pane sash except for the first floor of the frame section which has six over six pane sash. The house has three front doors, two in the original section in the second and third bays from the west end. Another entrance is constructed into the addition against what was the east end wall of the main section. The many doors suggest that this has served as an apartment building or a combined commercial and residential structure. Visible exterior features date from the 20th century although the log building is much older, and may date from the 1830s.

The 1877 Atlas map shows this property belonging to H. Skilling.
