Description:

This commercial structure, now housing Glenn's Tavern appears to date from the early 20th century and shows influence of the Spanish Colonial Revival style. Walls are constructed of rock-faced concrete block or "patent" stone. It is a seven-bay-wide building with single pane sash windows. At each end of the second floor front are semi-hexagonal projecting bays. Entrances are located in the second, third, fifth and sixth bays. First floor windows are larger than those at the second floor with plate glass and transoms. A distinctive feature is the overhanging pent roof supported by massive brackets.

The present building either conceals or replaces an earlier building on this lot which was owned by E. Flynn.
