Description:

It is almost impossible to suggest a construction date for this stucco and aluminum sided one and a half story, three bay house on South Antietam Street. The first story is stuccoed and the upper half story, possibly an addition, is aluminum sided and includes two-bay shed wall dormers, front and back. Windows have single pane sash. The front entrance is in the central bay and sheltered by a hip-roofed porch.

This building is not shown on the 1877 Atlas map for Funkstown, although, as a former support structure, it would not have been depicted.


