Description:

This log building located at what was originally designed to be Funkstown's public square, is a two story, three bay L-shaped structure. It is covered with early 20th century siding with an oversized bead at the bottom edge. Most windows have two over two pane sash with arched upper panes. Windows have pairs of louvered shutters. There is a one story semi-hexagonal projecting bay at the west end of the front elevation. The main entrance is located in the center bay of the front elevation. A shed roofed porch extends across the front. It is supported by turned posts.

Originally this lot was one of four at this intersection designated to be the town square.

In the 1877 Atlas the property was owned by Mrs. Crawford.
