This one story commercial Moderne style building is located at the corner of Edgewood Drive and East Baltimore Street. It would appear to date from the 1940s and has a black and white Carrara glass surface with rounded corners and horizontal banding.

The building was originally a Nash car dealership. It has a showroom and display areas at its east end and what appears to have been garage bays.

The building is significant as the only Moderne style building in Funkstown and one of only a few in the county.
