Description:

Located on the southwest corner of Antietam and Chestnut Streets is this two story, five bay brick house. It has a symmetrical facade with a central entrance. Bricks are laid in Flemish bond at the front and jack arches are present above the openings. Windows have replaced single pane sash within moderately wide frames. A shed roofed porch across the front appears to be an added feature.

The house appears to date from the 1820s or '30s and is part of Funkstown's main development phase which coincided with the upgrade of the Baltimore Pike to become part of the National Road.

According to the 1877 Atlas map, this property belonged to F. Carley at that time.


