Description:

This foursquare style house shows influence of the Queen Anne style with a two story semi-hexagonal projecting bay beneath a pedimented roof. It is a three bay structure with a central entrance. Windows have single pane sash. A hip roofed porch supported by round columns extends across the front. Typical of foursquares, the house has a hipped roof. There is also a frontal pedimented dormer.

This place is characteristic of the early 20th century development which occurred on Funkstown's side streets.




