Description:

This frame American Foursquare style house is three bays wide and covered with German siding. Windows have six over one light sash beneath architraves with molded flat tops. The front north bay window is triple width. The main entrance is in the center bay. The house has the hipped roof, hip roofed dormers and wraparound porch typical of foursquares. An unusual feature is the fancy bracketed cornice.

Apparently, there was an earlier building on this site as indicated by the 1877 Funkstown Atlas map. It was occupied by J. Weller.


