Description:

Located on the northwest corner of Poplar and Antietam Streets is this one and a half story, three bay log house modified to resemble a bungalow. An added two bay shed dormer extends across the south slope of the roof. A large exterior stone chimney is located against the west end wall. The building is covered with aluminum siding. Windows have six over one light sash. The entrance is in the west end bay and is sheltered by a shed roofed porch. It appears that this house dates from the 19th century, but was remodeled in the 1920s or '30s.

In 1877, according to the Atlas map for Funkstown, the house belonged to F. Skilling.
