Description:

This L-shaped brick house is located at the northeast corner of West Side Avenue and West Chestnut Street. It is a two story, four bay brick structure laid in common bond. Windows have single pane sash within narrow frames. There are two central front doors, each with a diamond pane transom above the door.

This house was occupied by W. Furray in 1877 according to the Atlas map of that year.

It reflects mid 19th century housing construction in Funkstown.


