Description:

This one and a half story log house is covered with insul brick siding. Windows have single pane sash within architraves with pointed tops. The main entrance is located in the west bay of the front elevation. A shed roofed porch extends across the front. There is also a one story shed extension to the rear. The window trim and roof of this structure suggest a construction date in the 1880s. However, the log structure beneath may be older.

A house is shown on this site in the 1877 Atlas map owned by L. Troxhill.


