This two story, five bay frame house is covered with vinyl siding. Windows have single pane sash within architraves with pointed tops. The main entrance is located in the central bay. Character-defining features include a central cross gable and a partially replaced front porch with a pediment with carved trim. The cross gable and window trim are late variations of the Victorian Gothic style.
