Description:

This bungalow has been covered with vinyl siding but otherwise retains its character-defining features. It is a one and a half story, three bay house with a three bay wide shed dormer. Windows have single pane sash and the main entrance is in the central bay. The shed dormer has a recessed wall forming an upper level porch with a door for access. There is also the typical overhanging front porch supported by large square posts and enclosed with a balustrade.

This is one of several bungalows in Funkstown reflecting the town's development in the 1920s and '30s.


