This property consists of a two story frame house covered with vinyl siding, an attached one story kitchen and a frame detached garage. The house is a two story, three bay building, side gabled with a central entrance. There are only two bays at the second story level. Windows that appear to be original have two over two pane sash windows. Others have been modified with single pane sash. The first story south front window has been modified to become a triple sash window. The house rests on stone foundations. The date attribution is based on the light frame construction and general form of the building plus documentary evidence that this section of Maugansville was developed in the early 1900s.




