This property consists of a brick American Foursquare style house and a frame gable roofed garage. The house is constructed with all stretcher brick bonding. Windows are topped with segmental arches and have six over one light sash. Front elevation windows are doubled at the second story and tripled at the first story level. The main entrance has a colonial revival style elliptical fanlight and sidelights. A porch supported with square posts and brick piers extends across the front. The hipped roof is covered with asphalt shingles. The date attribution is based on the period of dominance of foursquare houses and 1920s era detailing, such as the window sash and entrance treatment. It represents Maugansville's major growth and development in the early 20th century.




