This gable fronted concrete block garage is now the service area for Brewer's Saab dealership in Maugansville. It is a two bay garage with an overhanging shed along the front. The old concrete block construction used for this building indicates that it was built during the first quarter of the 20th century. This site, however, was that which was occupied by J.T. Maugans' Wagon and Blacksmith Shop identified in the 1877 Washington County Atlas.




