This house is located on the east side of Maugansville Road, facing west. It is a two story, three bay side gabled frame house distinguished by a recessed double porch beneath its main roof span. The recessed porch covers about half of the front, encompassing the two southern bays. The house is covered with vinyl siding. Windows have two over two pane sash. The main entrance is in the central bay and is entered from the recessed porch. The porch is embellished with a cutwork balustrade at both levels, supported by chamfered square posts. A brick chimney with a corbeled top is located inside the north gable end. A limestone wall defines the house yard along its north and east sides. The top of the wall has pairs of upright pointed stones in a finishing technique typical of the 1920s and 1930s. Behind the house is a large, two story chicken house which has been modified possibly to form a garage. Dating features on this house include the frame construction, two over two windows and the recessed double porch. With the porch, it is representative of an important regional vernacular type which was prominent from the 1830s through the 1870s and which is associated with the Pennsylvania Germans. A house is shown on this site on the 1877 Atlas of Washington County.




