Located on the east side of Maugansville Road and facing west is this two story, four bay frame house with side gables. Walls are covered with vinyl siding, and a porch across the front has been partially enclosed, covering two bays. Windows have single pane sash. At the first story, south bay, the windows are doubled. The main entrance is in the second bay from the south end of the front wall. A brick flue with a corbeled top is located inside the north gable. The front yard is defined by a poured concrete retaining wall and steps leading to a walkway. The house is representative of Maugansville's conservative architectural expression during its main growth phase in the early 20th century.




