Located on the west side of Maugansville Road and set well back from the road is this frame foursquare style house. Although its integrity has been lost by the application of vinyl siding, and the replacement of its windows, the house still retains its typical foursquare form with its square shape and hipped roof. It is two bays wide with a window and door at the first story front. A porch across the front is supported by square columns. One original exterior feature is the brick chimney which has a corbeled top. This house, although altered represents Maugansville's main growth phase in the early 20th century. The date attribution is based on the time period of the foursquare style in central and western Maryland.




