This bungalow is located on the southwest corner of Maugansville Road and Alpine Drive. Built of brick and frame, it is three bays wide with a central entrance. It has the characteristic bungalow form with one and a half stories, a large dormer and an overhanging porch. The foundations are of rock-faced concrete block, and the walls of the first story are brick with cast stone lintels, sills and coping. The gables, dormer and enclosed rear porch are covered with lapped wood siding. The porch is supported by large square posts resting on brick piers. The substantial roof overhang is supported by wooden triangle brackets. Windows have three over one light sash. This is a highly intact example of a bungalow. It reflects Maugansville's main growth phase in the early 20th century.






