This Dutch Colonial house is located on the east side of Village Mill Drive. It is a one and a half story, three bay frame building, covered with aluminum siding. It has the characteristic gambrel roof and shed dormer. At the first story front, the fenestration consists of a door and a three part window. Windows have three vertical lights in the upper sash, with single panes below. A porch supported by tapered square posts extends across the front. The date attribution for this house is based on the period of popularity for the Dutch Colonial style. This is one of the later examples within the period of study for this survey.




