Located on the northwest corner of Village Mill Drive and Leona Avenue is this L-shaped frame house. The L is configured to give the house gabled projections to the front (east) and to the south. The walls have been covered with vinyl siding, except that decorative shingles remain within the gables. The front elevation consists of two bays, a door and a three part window. Other windows have single pane sash. Character defining features include pent roofs across the gables, a standing seam roof, and a pedimented wraparound porch. The porch is now supported by decorative metal columns. The yard area is bordered by a stone wall with coping of upright pointed stones. A small frame gabled stable is located behind the house. It has been converted to a garage. The architectural features suggest a building date of approximately 1910. It represents Maugansville's main growth period in the early 20th century.




