On the east side of Village Mill Drive and in close company with a row of similar houses is this two story, three bay frame house dating from the early 20th century. It is covered with aluminum siding which also encloses a front porch. A two story wing is attached to the rear of the building. The facade arrangement consists of three bays at the first story level, two doors and a window, and only two windows at the second story level. Windows have two over two pane sash. Brick chimneys with corbeled tops are located inside the gabled ends. A gable roofed garage is located at the rear of the property. Visible original architectural features and the fenestration pattern suggest the ca. 1910 construction date. The house represents Maugansville's main growth period in the early 20th century.




