This two story gable sided frame house is located on the east side of Village Mill Drive. It is four bays wide and covered with aluminum siding. The first story front has four bays, window, door, window, window; while the second floor has only three windows. Windows have two over two pane sash and are trimmed with vinyl or aluminum shutters. A porch across the front is supported by chamfered posts. A one story shed extension is attached at the rear. The only chimney is a modern concrete block flue. A frame gable roofed garage is located at the rear of the property. Based on overall form and the few remaining architectural details, this house like its neighbors dates from about 1910. It represents Maugansville's main period of growth in the early 20th century.




