Approximate date Ca. 1890-1900

On the east side of Village Mill Drive is this two story three bay frame house which retains most of its original exterior finishes. It is covered with narrow gauge wooden siding and retains original window and door trim which consists of architraves with peaks or points at the tops with applied cut work trim. These suggest a construction date in the 1890s. The fenestration pattern at the front consists of three bays with a window, door, window arrangement at the first story, and only two windows at the second story level. This pattern is associated with the 1890-1910 period in Washington County and the surrounding area. The front door is protected by a shed roofed entrance porch supported by turned posts. Brick chimneys with corbeled tops are located inside the gable ends. A one story shed extension, probably an enclosed porch is located at the rear of the house. This house is important as one of a small number of frame dwellings in Maugansville that retains most of its exterior coverings and features. It is representative of the village's main growth period in the late 19th and early 20th centuries.


