Similar to many of its neighbors on Village Mill Drive, is this two story, three bay frame house, dating from the early 20th century. It has a window, door, window arrangement at the first story level and only two windows at the second story. This particular house has received all new exterior finishes and features, including vinyl siding and shutters, new six light windows, and replaced porches with vinyl or metal clad columns. Attached to the rear, south corner of the house is a one story gabled wing which probably originally served as a kitchen or summer kitchen. Although substantially altered, the house does reflect Maugansville's major growth phase in the early 20th century. This house is typical of the early 1900s in Maugansville.




