On the east side of Village Mill Drive is this frame foursquare style house resting on rock-faced concrete block foundations. It has the characteristic foursquare features of a hipped roof and dormer and square plan. It has three bays across the front with a central entrance. At the second story level there are two windows. Windows have single pane sash and those at the first story front are slightly larger than the others. A porch across the front is supported by large square columns. A side entrance is sheltered by a gabled hood with brackets. A corbeled chimney extends from inside the south wall. Foursquares were very common from 1910-1925, and this example is no exception. It is indicative of Maugansville's main development period.




