Located on the northeast corner of Eby Lane and Village Mill Drive is this two story, three bay frame house covered with aluminum siding. An extension to the rear of the building gives it a T shape. A semi hexagonal projecting bay is attached to the north gable end. The building rests on rock faced concrete block foundations. Windows have single pane sash within flat-topped architraves. Aluminum or vinyl shutters have been added. A porch across the front is supported with decorative metal columns. The rear extension has a two story porch on its south side. A brick chimney with a corbeled top is located inside the south gable end. This house is typical of many in Maugansville, particularly on Village Mill Drive, which date from the early 20th century.




