This brick foursquare style house is located on the east side of Village Mill Drive, among similar houses south of Eby Lane. It has a two bay wide facade and rests on rock-faced concrete block foundations. Bricks are laid in all stretcher bond. Windows have single pane and several are doubled. The first story front window is tripled. The house has the characteristic foursquare hipped roof with a frontal hipped dormer. A porch across the front is supported by tapered square posts resting on brick piers with concrete coping. Behind the house is a frame foursquare garage. These foursquare houses illustrate Maugansville's major growth period in the early 1900s.




