This brick foursquare, one among many on Village Mill Drive, is two bays wide at the front elevation and rests on rock-faced concrete block foundations. Windows at the front are single pane sash, doubled. The house has the usual hipped roof with a frontal hipped dormer. The front door includes a narrow transom. A porch across the front is supported by large square posts resting on brick piers with cast stone coping. The numerous foursquares in this part of Maugansville help to portray the village as an early 20th century community.


