Located on the east side of Village Mill Drive among a sizable group of foursquares, is this ca. 1910 frame house with vestigial Queen Anne influence. It is an L-shaped frame building with a forward projecting gable roofed section. It has been completely clad in vinyl, including, seemingly the rough shakes within the gables. Windows have single pane sash. A distinctive feature are the front windows which are larger than the rest, and which contain upper transoms. A wraparound porch is supported by square posts. Old concrete walkways extend from the sidewalk to the front and along the south side of the house to the kitchen wing. One of the older houses in the immediate vicinity, this property illustrates the development of the southern half of Maugansville.




