This house located on the west side of village Mill Drive is a Colonial Revival style influenced foursquare house. It is of brick construction with a hipped roof and a wraparound front porch with a central pediment. A gabled extension is located at the rear of the building. The bricks are laid in all stretcher bond and rest on rock faced block foundations. Windows have single pane sash with segmentally arched tops and are doubled at the front of the building. The main entrance is centrally placed and includes wide sidelights and a three part transom. The porch is supported by square posts resting on brick piers with rock faced coping. A brick chimney with a corbeled top extends from the interior of the building. Although this house dates from the early 20th century, like most of the buildings in Maugansville, it is among the larger dwellings. According to local informants, this was known as the Rowland Property and greenhouses were located here.




