This traditional, conservative house probably dates from about 1910. It is a two story, four bay, side gabled brick house with a window, door, door, window arrangement. The facade arrangement with two center front doors, is a traditional Germanic plan which was common in Washington County from the 18th through the 20th centuries. The house is constructed on stone foundations with all stretcher brickwork and segmental arches above the openings. Windows have single pane sash and the front doors each have a single pane transom. Across the front is a porch supported by turned posts. A one story kitchen extension is attached to the rear of the building. Features characteristic of the early 20th century construction date are the segmental arches over the openings, single pane sash, and the all stretcher brickwork. This house emblematic of the main growth phase in Maugansville in the early 20th century, and the overall conservative nature of the buildings in the community.


