This foursquare is nearly identical to its immediate neighbors, except that its window and door arrangement at the front elevation have been reversed. It is a brick building with all stretcher bond resting on rock faced block foundations. It has a shed roofed frontal dormer with a double window. Windows have single pane sash with cast stone sills. The porch, like the others in the group is supported with square posts on brick piers. They are connected by a wooden balustrade. A one story extension is attached to the rear. A poured concrete retaining wall rims an alleyway between this property and the next to the south which is adjacent to the railroad. This group, presumably all built in 1927, possibly by NK Johnston, whose name appears on the date tablet for 13737 Village Mill Drive, next door to the north, is typical of Maugansville's main development period which occurred in the early 20th century.




