This brick house located near the south end of Maugansville on Village Mill Drive is a large and substantial house apparently dating from about 1900. It is a two story building, five bays wide, with only four bays at the second story level. Brick work is in all stretcher bond and openings are topped with segmental arches. Windows have single pane sash and one set of windows in the north gable wall is doubled. A one story flat roofed extension is added at the rear. The main entrance is located in the center bay of the front elevation and includes a transom. A hip roofed porch extends across the front and is supported by vinyl clad columns. Brick chimneys with corbeled tops are located inside the gable ends. A frame stable converted to a garage is located behind the house. The date attribution is based on the all stretcher brickwork, segmental arches, single pane windows and small chimneys. This house is among the more substantial and larger in Maugansville and reflects the early 20th century character of the village.
