This frame house is located at the south edge of Maugansville. Typical of many dwellings on Village Mill Drive, it has three bays at the first story and only two windows at the second story level, an architectural expression associated with the early 20th century. The house is covered with either asbestos or masonite siding and rests on rock faced concrete block foundations. Windows have single pane sash. The entrance is located in the center bay of the front elevation. Another door is located at the east edge of the south gable wall. Small corbeled chimneys are located inside the end walls. A three bay porch supported by square posts is located at the front. Behind the house is a small, frame gable roofed shed. The date attribution is based on the overall form, cast stone foundations and small chimneys. It is representative of the modest architecture from the early 20th century that characterizes Maugansville.
