This two story L-shaped frame house is located on the east side of Village Mill Drive. It is a three bay residence with a central entrance. The outer covering is asbestos shingle siding. Windows have single pane sash within architraves with molded flat tops. A one story semi hexagonal projecting bay is located north of the front entrance. It appears that the entrance had a transom that has been enclosed. A hip roofed porch extends across the front and is supported by turned posts. A two story L extends to the rear with a one story shed roofed addition or enclosed porch. A corbeled brick chimney is located inside the south gable end. A poured concrete curb and walkway defines the front of the property. Date attribution is based on the light frame construction, single pane sash windows, the type of architraves and the small chimney. This modest house, conservative in design is typical of many in Maugansville, particularly those along Village Mill Drive. It reflects Maugansville's overall 20th century character.
