This very intact foursquare style house is located on the east side of Village Mill Drive a short distance south of the railroad. It is a frame building resting on rock-faced concrete block foundations. The first story is German sided and the second is covered with stucco, a favorite combination for foursquares, although distinctive in Maugansville. Windows have four vertical lights in the upper sashes over a single pane lower sash. The first story front is a triple window. Other features are typical of foursquares: hipped roof, dormer and across-the-front porch. The house is notable for its high level of integrity. It is indicative of Maugansville's 20th century character.
