Located just south of the railroad on the east side of Village Mill Drive is this stuccoed frame house. It is a two story, five bay dwelling with a central entrance, retaining influence from the Georgian style in a conservative early 20th century vernacular form. Windows have single pane sash with vinyl shutters. Across the front is a hip roofed porch supported by turned posts with decorative curved brackets and trim. The porch is an original feature and helps to date the house to the early 20th century. Brick chimneys with corbeled tops are located inside the gable ends. A poured concrete curb defines the front of the property. The light frame construction and small chimneys also help to provide the date attribution for the house. It helps to define Maugansville as an early 20th century community with conservative architectural expression.
