Description of Property and Eligibility Determination: *(Use continuation sheet if necessary and attach map and photo)*

This 3-bay, 2-story side gabled single family residence is located on the south side of US 40 (the National Pike) in Huyett. According to the tax records, it was built in 1915. The structure has synthetic siding and asphalt shingles and has a one-story full width porch that has been partially enclosed. The house may be the same structure that appears on the USGS map in 1912 in this location. There is a one-story addition attached to the east side of the house. The windows are one over one and appear to have exterior storm windows. The entrance door is a wood two-paneled single light door.

Although located on the National Road in the crossroads community of Huyett, this house has been significantly altered and lacks sufficient integrity to be eligible for the National Register of Historic Places. The property is not known to be associated with the lives of persons significant in the local, state, or national past (Criteria B). The property does not embody the distinctive characteristics of a type; period or method of construction represent the work of a master; or possess high artistic values (criteria C). Finally, the property is not likely to yield information important in local, state, or national prehistory or history (criteria D).


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
