Description of Property and Eligibility Determination: *(Use continuation sheet if necessary and attach map and photo)*

This cement block commercial building is located on the north side of US 40 (the National Pike). The exact date of construction is known, however, it was probably built after 1924 as a gas and service station. A glass entrance door and two six-over-six windows on the west side of the building. On the east side there are two large garage doors. The building now is used as a fencing company. There is a large metal addition attached to the east side of the building.

Although associated with the Huyett community and the National Road, this structure does not retain enough integrity to be eligible for the National Register of Historic Places. The property is not known to be associated with events that have made a significant contribution to the broad patterns of local, state or national history (criteria A). The property is not known to be associated with the lives of persons significant in the local, state, or national past Criteria B). The property does not embody the distinctive characteristics of a type; period or method of construction represent the work of a master; or possess high artistic values (criteria C). Finally, the property is not likely to yield information important in local, state, or national prehistory or history (criteria D).

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


