The dwelling at 368 Pangborn Blvd in Hagerstown, Washington County, MD is not located in an historic district, nor is it eligible for individual listing on the National Register of Historic Places.

The building is a 1-1/2-story frame bungalow-type dwelling with craftsmen detailing. Set upon a slightly raised concrete foundation, the house is covered with a broad and wide gable roof with a wide, central gable dormer, with exposed rafter ends. The dwelling follows a typical mid-20th-century domestic building form and, because of significant alterations and changes, does not survive as a good example of its type and form. The building does not have the architectural distinctiveness or integrity necessary to qualify it for listing under Criterion C. The property is not known to have associations with persons or events significant to our past and is thus not eligible under Criteria A or B.


