The house at 11109 ~~1109~~ Lincoln Avenue does not appear to meet the National Register Criteria for individual listing or for district nomination. The modest bungalow is representative of an extremely common house type throughout Maryland. This is a rather poor example of the type as it has been clad in artificial siding. Similar houses with more integrity exist within the immediate neighborhood. The property is not known to be associated with any event or persons significant in history. Based on a site visit, we believe Halfway does not constitute an historic district. This turn-of-the century suburb of Hagerstown, has undergone rapid growth in recent decades and no longer retains a sense of place or integrity.
