DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

This house is located at the edge of Maryland Route 68, west of Barnes Road and northwest of Boonsboro in Washington County, Maryland. It is situated at the edge of the road facing south. This building is a small one story, three bay structure, presumably of log construction. Foundations are stone covered with layers of stucco or whitewash. The walls are sheathed with composition simulated brick siding. Thick door and window jambs, however, suggest that the walls are log. The door is centrally located.

Windows have plain 20th century trim and two over two pane sashes. Corrugated sheet metal covers the roof and a modern concrete block flue has been added against the east end wall.

The house is in fair to good condition.


